Wesley J. Smith

special quest speaker

Lawyer and award-winning author, Wesley J. Smith, is the host of the *Humanize* podcast and Chair of the Discovery Institute's Center on Human Exceptionalism. In 2004, he was named

one of the nation's premier experts in bioengineering by the National Journal. In 2008, the Human Life Foundation named him a Great Defender of Life for his work against assisted suicide and euthanasia.

Smith's book Forced Exit: Euthanasia, Assisted Suicide and the New Duty to Die, a broad-based criticism of the assisted suicide/euthanasia movement, has become a classic in anti-euthanasia advocacy. He has published hundreds of articles and appeared on thousands of TV and radio programs across the U.S. and internationally. Smith is often called upon by members of the legislative and executive branches of government to advise on issues within his fields of expertise.
